Jeff Milton's life in law enforcement reads like a movie. After spending three years as a Texas Ranger, he patrolled the Mexican border between El Paso and Yuma capturing smugglers bringing in mescal and Chinese immigrants. He had an altercation with John Wesley Hardin and lived to tell about it. In 1900 he fought five members of the Alvord gang who attempted to rob his train at Fairbank. After an exciting life, he died in Tucson in 1947.
